Re: Approval of the adoption of Envision Math Program 6-12

Date: April 21, 2020

During the course of last school year and this current school year, an extensive review of 6-12 math programs has been conducted. This year we piloted the Envision mathematics program published by Pearson. The Envision pilot group voted to move forward with the adoption of the program in January. This recommendation was then reviewed by the Instructional Materials Committee on March 4, 2020 as per board policy 2020. The notes from the meeting are attached.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board approves the and adopts the Pearson Envision Program 6-12 mathematics with a publish date of 2018.

- The purpose of the IMC meeting was to review the Envision 6-12 mathematics program.
- Doug Flickner and Allissa Donovan presented information about the middle school program. They discussed how assignments could be modified, how they used the on-line pieces, and how students were responding to the program. Doug talked about modifications he had made to the assignments, but said that was his preference and the program was solid without these adjustments.
- John Hildenbrand, Jennifer McFall and Alison Dickinson talked about Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II. They discussed the on-line access for students and really liked the precision that the on-line piece requires. They also indicated that at the beginning of the year students were not excited about the program, but now they appreciate it. This was attributed to immediate feedback and becoming familiar with the program.
- The Instructional Materials Committee members asked questions about the program and then voted to approve the Envision 6-12 mathematics program published by Pearson, 2018.
- The Instructional Materials Committee recommended that the approval and adoption of the Envision Program be recommended to the School Board of Directors.
